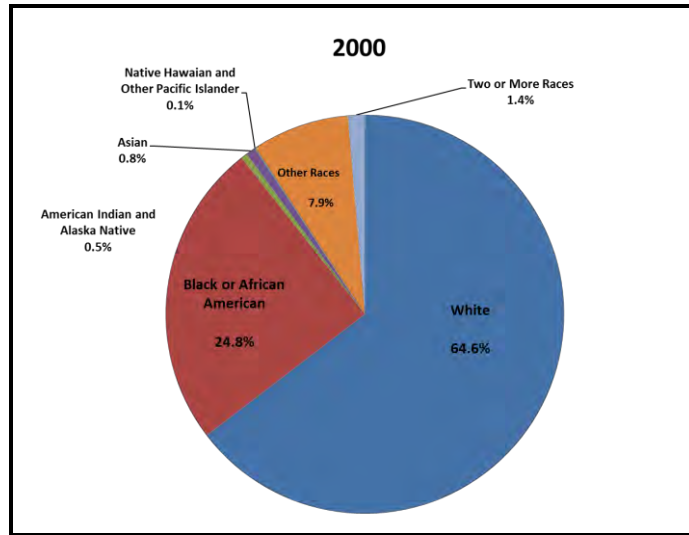

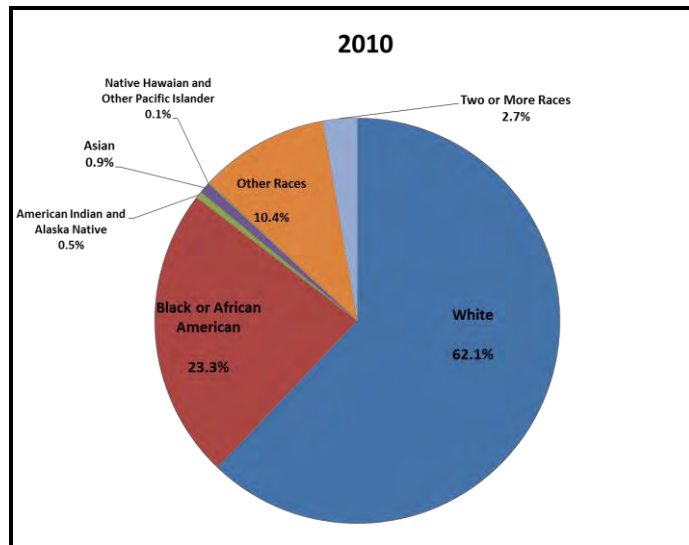

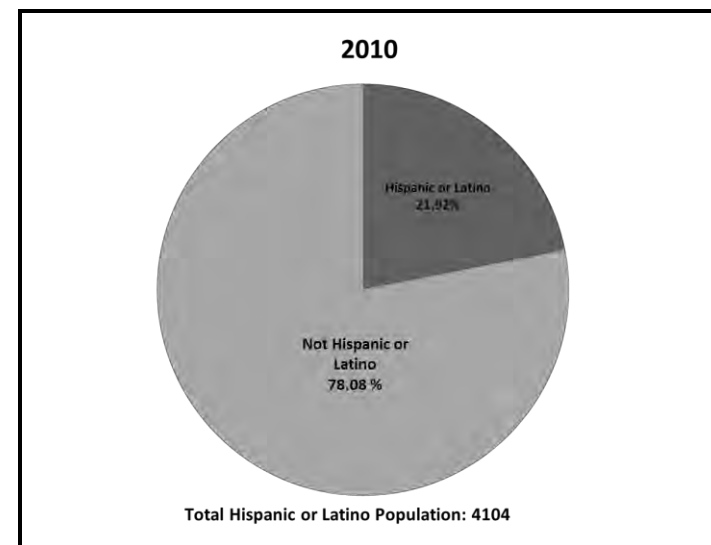
2000 Palestine by race (resource: 2000 Census)



2000 Palestine by ethnicity (resource: 2000 Census)

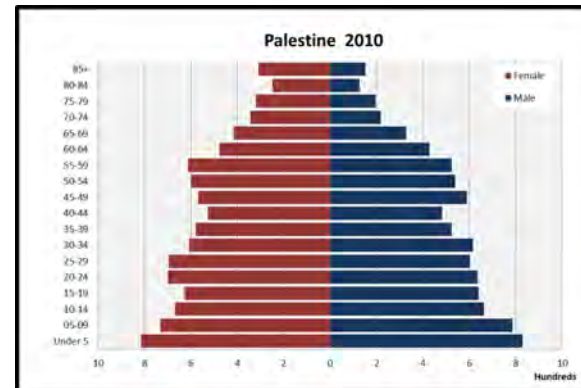
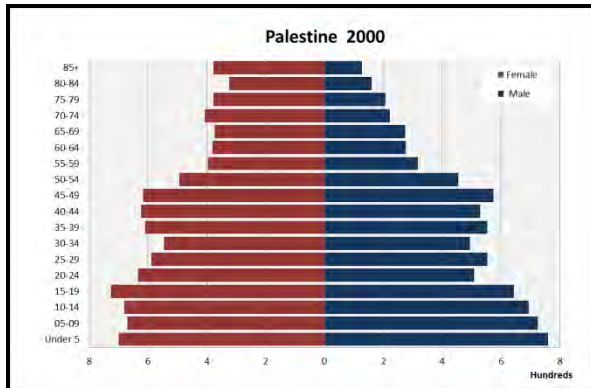
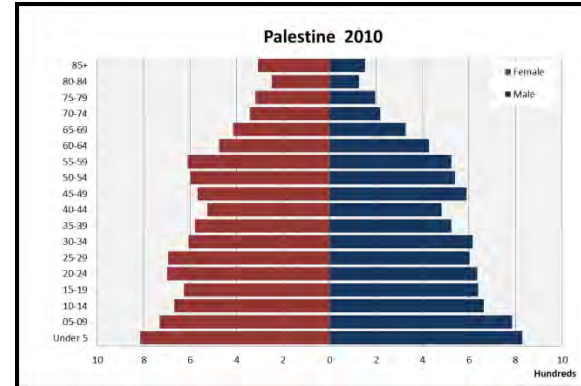
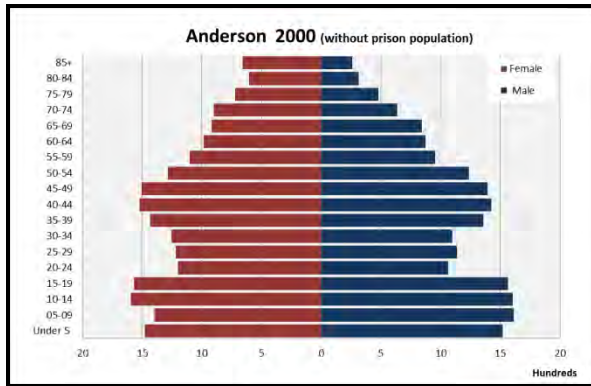
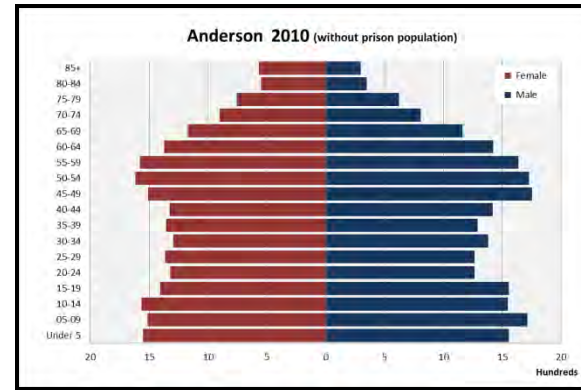
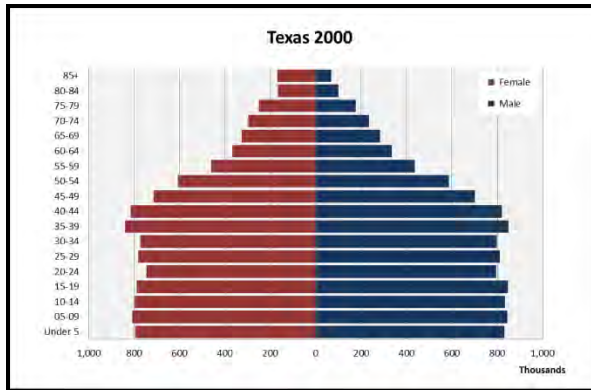

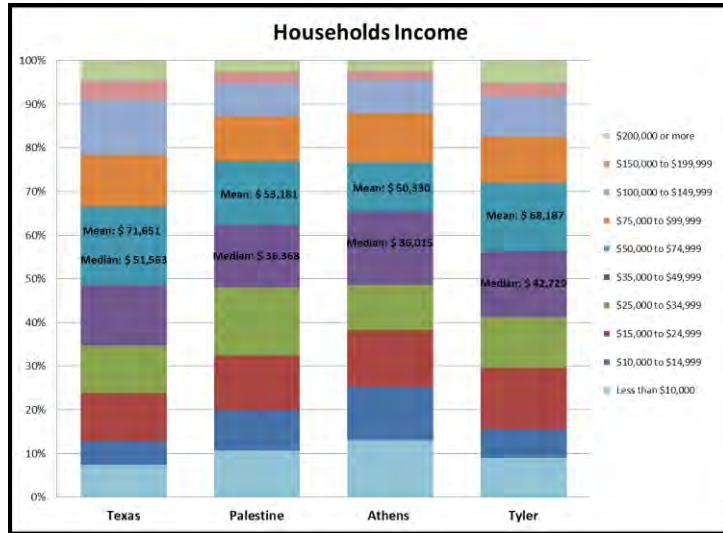

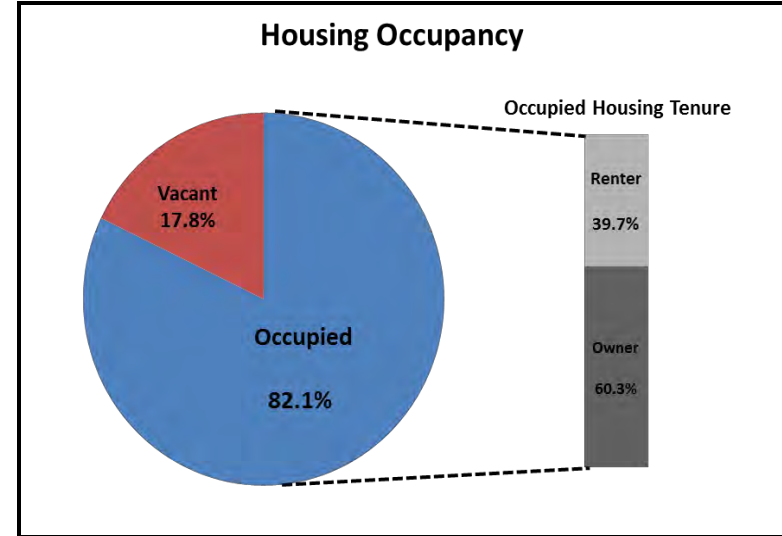
Appendix A-2: Age and Gender Pyramids (resource: 2000 & 2010 Census)



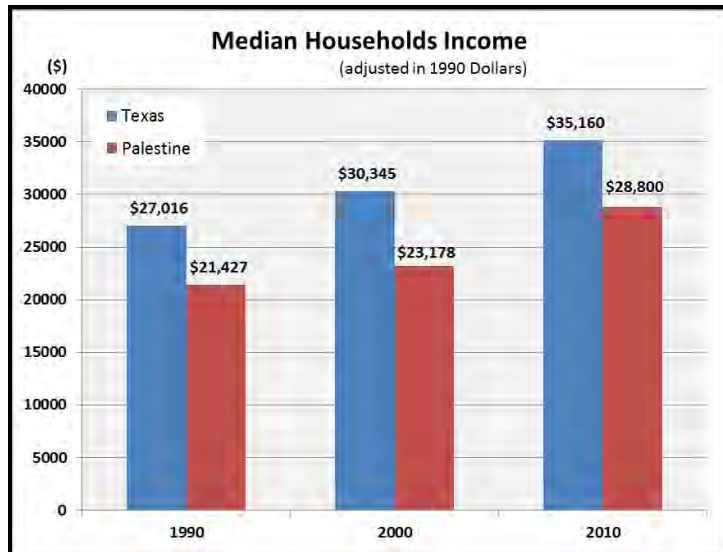

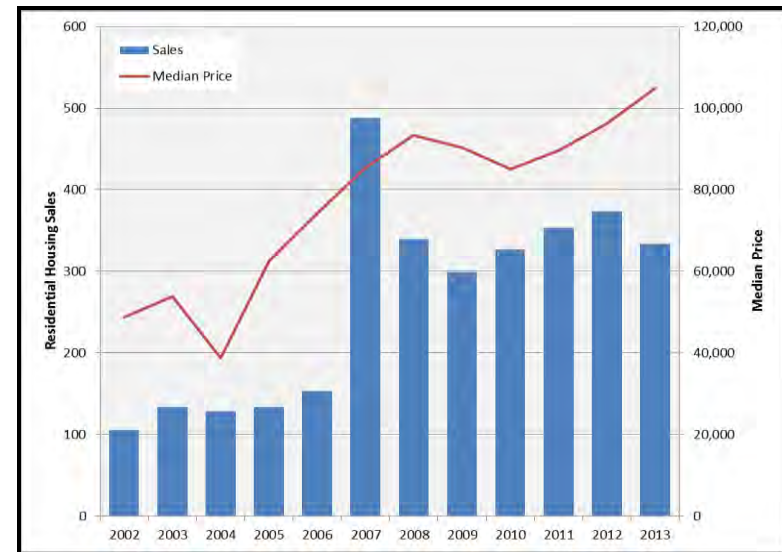
Detailed households income by Texas and cities (resource: ACS 2008-2012 5 year)

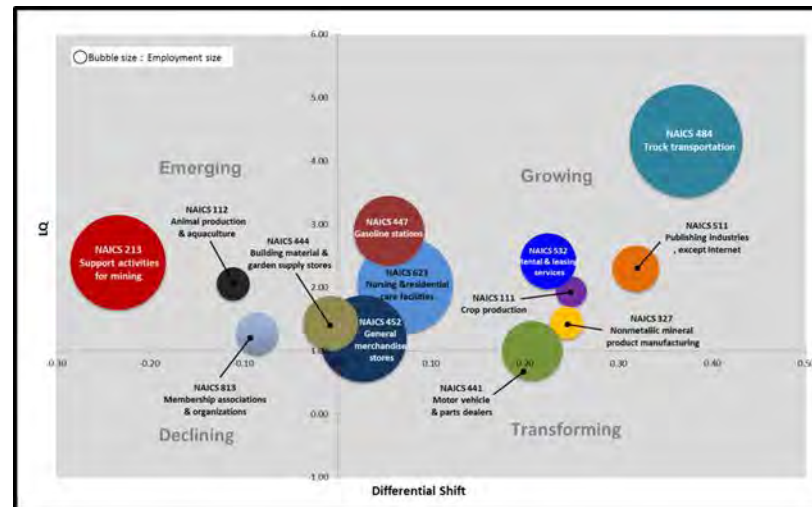

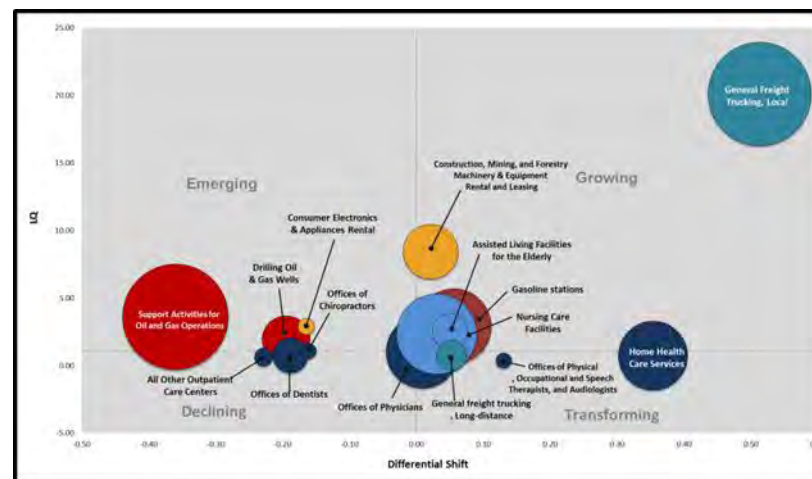

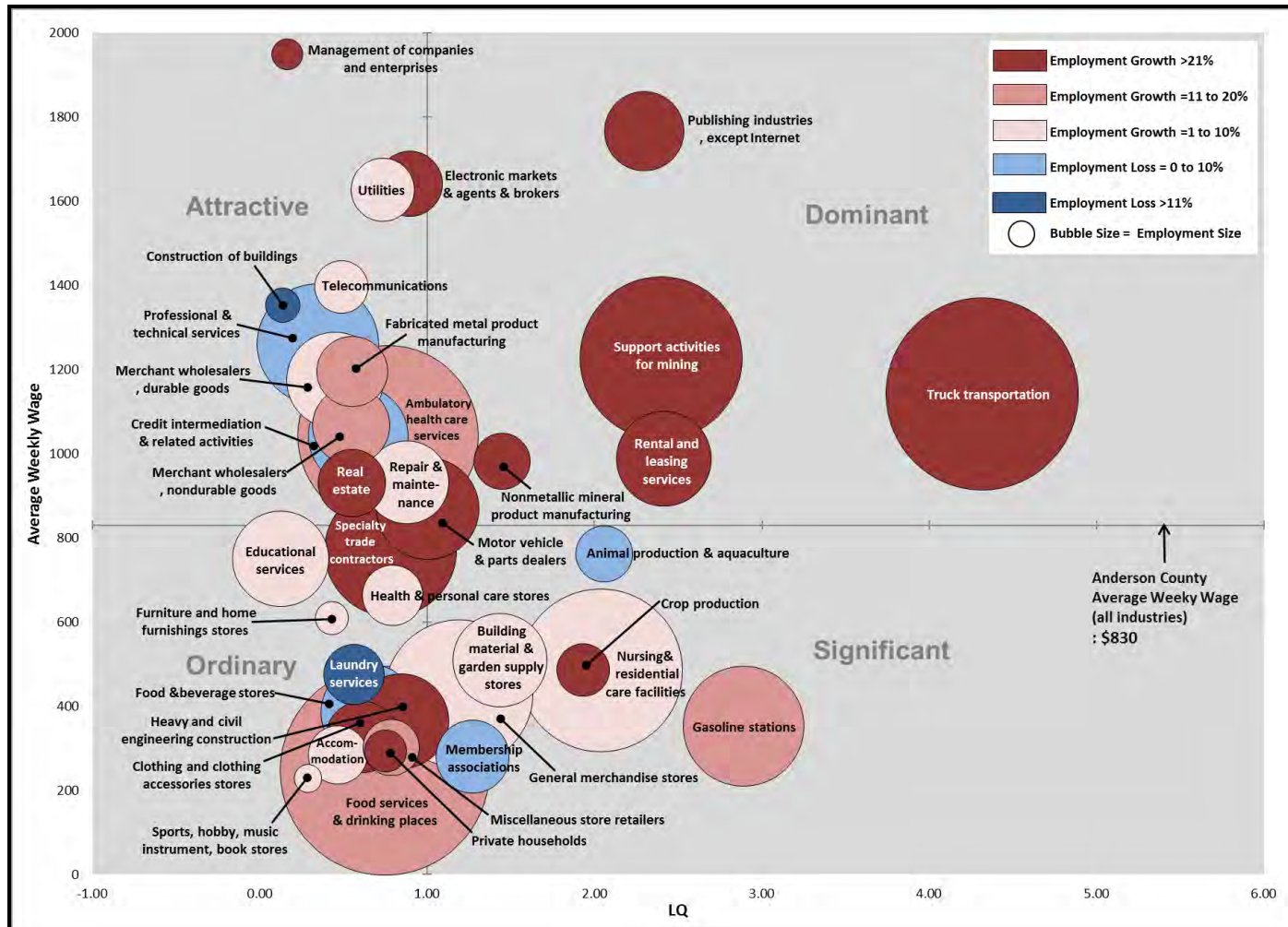
Emerging and growing industries in Palestine with respect to Texas

How to interpret this chart

1. Industries in attractive quadrant are yet relatively low concentration of workers with respect to Texas, but they are providing high wages and are critical to Anderson's wealth creation.
2. Industries in dominant quadrant have strong concentration of workers as well as higher wage jobs than Anderson's average wage.
3. Industries in significant quadrant are high concentration of workers but low wages. These industries tend to contribute to Anderson's employment base.
4. Industries in ordinary quadrant are last to receive economic development attention due to low concentration of workers and low wages.
